Objectives	Education and training for young people (CEF) programmes aim at fulfilling compulsory schooling and insertion in the active life.	
Admission requirements	<p>Age: 15 year old or over.</p> <p>Access qualifications:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Type 5 - holder of the 10th year of schooling or equivalent, or attendance of the 11th year without success, or type 4 holder, or 10th year of vocational programme, or level 2 initial qualification course with complementary training; - Type 6 - holder of the 11th year of schooling or equivalent or attendance of the 12th year without success; - Type 7 - Holder of the 12th year of a general (scientific-humanistic) programme or equivalent of upper secondary education in the same or similar field of study. 	
Organisation of provision	<p>CEF programmes are organised sequentially.</p> <p>The curriculum structure is highly professional and appropriate to the qualification levels targeted, taking into account the specificity of the respective training areas, and comprise the following training components: sociocultural; scientific; technological; practical.</p>

Evaluation	The evaluation is continuous (formative) and allows readjusting the teaching-learning process and the establishment of a recovery plan.	

	The <i>prova de avaliação final</i> (PAF - final assessment test) comprises one or more practical works based on the activities of the required profile and is done in front of a tripartite jury.
Certification	The successful completion of a CEF leads to a double certification: a) upper secondary education and, b) professional qualification level 4 of EQF, depending on the path realised.
Progression	The successful conclusion of a CEF type 5, 6 or 7 allows to continue studies in: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a similar area of a technological specialisation programme; - an higher level course or programme, if learners fulfil the requirements set on the rules to access high education.
